As part of 2015's Bull Charge Beneficiaries Outreach, SGX organised a trip to Gardens by the Bay for the children from Fei Yue Community Services on 10 September. 27 volunteers from SGX and 47 children from Fei Yue Community Services participated in the half-day event which included a scavenger hunt at the Flower Dome and Cloud Forest, as well as a dinner party at Texas Chicken in Gardens by the Bay.
